biologist Bob Luce. If you don't know one bird from the other don't worry, Bob does! You will learn how to identify a variety of birds and how to use field guides. Although this workshop focuses on the beginner, experienced bird

watchers will have the opportunity to observe over 130 species of birds, some of which occur only in southeastern Arizona.

This workshop is a great way to reconnect with nature and more fully appreciate the natural beauty and diversity that surrounds us.
